- Demo papers describing innovative tools and prototypes. They will be presented as demos.

Both types of papers must not exceed 10 pages in the CEUR-ART format (one column style). See <http://ceur-ws.org/Vol-XXX/> for authors guidelines.

Papers should be submitted in PDF format through the conference management system available at TBD.

The submitted papers must be unpublished and must not be under review elsewhere.

The papers accepted for the PoEM2020 Forum will be published in volume in the CEUR-WS.org series.

This year, the publication of papers to the Forum is organised as post-proceedings which allows authors of forum submissions to further improve / polish their submission after the event.
